



Student Guide to Virtual School Day

A. **What is a Virtual School Day?**

Virtual School Day is a Phoenix school day where students and teachers will be working, but it will look very different from a regular school day. Students will not have to be in the building on a Virtual School Day.

B. **How will a Virtual School Day work?**

Your teachers will give you an assignment for that day ahead of time. Some assignments will require the use of a computer and some will not.

C. **What if I don't have a computer at home?**

If you don't have a computer at home, then you may go to a friend's house, the public library, or you may use a computer at Phoenix during 11 AM to 2 PM.

D. **What if I don't turn in my assignment from Virtual School Day?**

If you don't turn in your assignment from Virtual School Day, then you will be given a zero for the assignment.

E. **How can I use a school computer for a school assignment on a Virtual School Day?**

If you wish to use a computer at school, you may come between the hours of 11 AM and 2 PM. Lab 1.122 will be open and monitored for student use. Students should sign in at the front desk and should go nowhere else in the building unless accompanied by a staff member.

F. **What are the designated times? What if I need to make up a test?**

Students will be allowed in the school building to make up a test or use a computer lab between 11 AM and 2 PM only.

G. **What if I need childcare?**

Childcare will be provided (for students with a child in the Parenting Center). See Ms. Floyd in the Parenting Center for details.

H. **What about breakfast and lunch?**

Breakfast and lunch will **NOT** be served on Virtual School Days.
